### ABOUT US

- With Veganaut we want to connect individual consumers, innovative producers, grassroots activists and NGOs, empowering them to make more and better vegan food accessible everywhere.
- Veganaut's core team is Toby (CTO) and Sebu (CEO). We're brothers, we're from Bern, and as a hobby we run a vegan event and catering project together with a few friends. Toby is head of development at Nothing Interactive (they won a silver medal at the latest Best of Swiss Web) and works for Veganaut in his free time, Sebu is self-employed and Veganaut is his main project. Very important: We'll be on holiday for two weeks starting on July 11<sup>th</sup>. Very important to us, that is.
- When we organize hackathons our team grows and we get a lot of coding done quickly. Some of the participants continue to develop for Veganaut after the hackathons on a volunteer basis. We've also started to work with payed freelancers, which up to now has been more educational than productive :-)
